Also I give & bequeath to my daughter MARGARET two delft dishes & one dozen ???, half of my wearing apparel & four chairs, one bed quilt ???.

I give & bequeath unto my grand-daughter **POLLY ETHERINGTON** my bed I lay on & the furniture that belongs to it & a spotted coverlet & a check counter and pen and two pewter dishes & half a dozen pewter plates, half a dozen of spoons, half a dozen of knives & forks, two cows & calves, two year old heifer, four chairs and the other half of my wearing apparel, one big pot, oven skillet, one trunk, one hackle, one smoothing iron & little wheel & ??? fork, my tea ???, two pair of cards and all other part of my estate not mentioned in this will shall be & remain in the hands of my daughter **MARGARET** & at her disposal.

And also do constitute & appoint my daughter **MARGARET ETHERINGTON** executor of this my last will & testament.
