The last will & testament of **JAMES [TIPPIN] TIPPING**, deceased, was proven in open court by **DAVID GORDON [JORDAN]**, an evidence thereto approved & allowed & ordered to be recorded and that the letters of administration formerly granted be revoked & the bond given up, an that letters testamentary issue to **WILLIAM RAINEY**, one of the executors named in said will, **DAVID GORDON**, the other executor, having refused to qualify.

Said **WILLIAM RAINEY** came into open court & took the oath required by law.
