

Deed, GA, Putnam, William Taylor to Mary Bryan, 1819

Putnam County

KNOW ALL MEN by these presents that I, **WILLIAM TAYLOR** of the aforesaid state and county, have, for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred dollars to me in hand paid, by **MARY [BRYAN] BRYANT** and **JOSIAH FLOURNOY**, bargained, sold and conveyed unto **JOSIAH FLOURNOY**, of the aforesaid state and county in trust for the use of **MARY BRYANT**, personally, all that tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the aforesaid state and county whereon the said the said **WILLIAM TAYLOR** now lives distinguished by lying in the county formerly Baldwin and in second district thereof known by No. 270, the right and title of the aforesaid premises I bind myself, my heirs & c. to warrant and defend to the said **JOSIAH FLOURNOY** in trust for the use of the said **MARY BRYANT** their heirs & c. which said premises are subject to the disposition of said **MARY BRYANT** either by will or otherwise.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF I have hereunto caused my hand and seal to be affixed this 18th day of March 1819.
