BETWEEN **HENRY MCCULLOH**, Esquire, of the kingdom of Great Britain & c. of the one part and **CHARLES BRUMFIELD** of Johnston County, in the province of North Carolina of the other part, planter.

NOW THIS INDENTURE, WITNESSETH, that for and in consideration of the sum of £24 Virginia money in hand paid by the said **CHARLES BRUMFIELD** to the said **HENRY MCCULLOH** both for himself and his heirs, gave, granted, bargained, sold and confirmed and by these presents hat given & c. unto the said **CHARLES BRUMFIELD**, his heirs and assigns forever, all that piece and parcel of land lying and being in the county of Johnston, aforesaid, being part of the tract No. 12.

Beginning at a Red Oak near a branch; running thence N58W 140 poles crossing Beaver Dam Creek, in all 192 poles to a White Oak; then S37W 228 poles to a Pine; thence S 80 poles, crossing the creek again, in all 120 poles to a White Oak; thence N68W 247 poles to a stake; thence to the beginning.

Containing in the whole 320 acres of land.

TO HAE AND TO HOLD to him, the said **CHARLES BRUMFIELD**, his heirs and assigns forever. (For what's let out, look at deed page 87).
