Know all men by these presents that I, **BENJAMIN BRIMER**, of Pendleton County and state of South Carolina, for and in consideration do deliver unto the said **WILLIAM LINARD** [LEONARD] a certain Negro woman, the name of BECK, after **BENJAMIN BRIMER** decease and **REBECCA BRIMER**, his wife, decease it being for value received which the said Negro I warrant and defend from an person or persons laying any right, title, or claim, to the said Negro.
