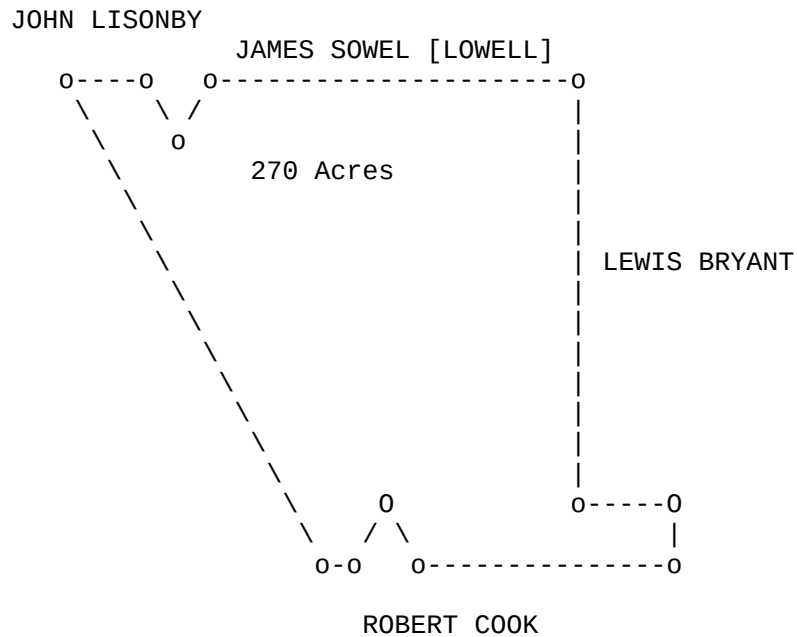


Deed, SC, Kershaw, John Lisonby, 1793
