
Deed, SC, York, Jonathan Beatty, 1810

Pursuant to a warrant from **FRANCIS ADAMS**, Esquire, Commissioner of Locations in the District of York dated the 30th day of October, 1810, I have admeasured and laid out unto Captain **JONATHAN BEATTY** a tract of land containing three hundred and thirty nine acres, situate in the said district on both sides of Fishing Creek waters of the Catawba River, bounded by a line running SE by **THOMAS DUNCAN**'s land, SW & SE by **JAMES CARREL**'s **[CARROLL]** & **THOMAS CARREL**'s **[CARROLL]** land; NW by **JONATHAN BEATTY**'s land, NW & BE by **HILL**'s & **HAYNES**' land; and hath such form and marks as the above plat represents.
