4th I will that the sum of eighty dollars be paid to my two daughters **MARY** [**CORDREY**] **HILLEARY** and **ELIZABETH CORDREY**, named women to be divided equally between them, share and share alike.

5th I will the rest, residue and remainder be it what it may, unto my sons **THOMAS CORDREY**, **NATHAN CORDREY**, **SHEPHERD** [SHEPERA] **CORDREY**, **NOBLE CORDREY**, **JACOB CORDREY** and **BARNETT CORDREY** to be equally divided amongst them, share and share alike.

6th I will that all the above mentioned legacies or sums of money shall be paid to the said respective legatees so soon as it can be collected or obtained after my decease, and hereby revoking all former wills by me made at any time.
