January 13th 1803

Memorandum of last will and testament of **BENJAMIN BRIMER** of the state of South Carolina and Pendleton District sheweth that I, **BENJAMIN BRIMER**, being sick of body but if perfect mind.

FIRST I do bequeath unto my wife **REBECCA BRIMER** on my movable property goods and chattels according to the interest thereof and no man to interfere.

This property to be divided as follows at her decease:

one third part to be given to **JESSEY BRIMER** one third part to be given to **NANCY MAUS** one third part to be given to **BETSEY LEONARD**

I like wise to give and bequeath unto CATY GABER fifty dollars.

I likewise do give and bequeath unto **REBECCA BRIMER** the child of **SAMUEL BRIMER**, deceased, five pound sterling.

I likewise do will and bequeath unto the under named persons five Shillings apiece:

WILLIAM BRIMER POLLY HANEY JAMES BRIMER

I likewise do desire **WILLIAM LEONARD** to see to the business given under my hand this day and your above written.
