ITEM. I will that all my just debts be paid.

Second. I will that the rest of my property be equally divided between my daughter **ELIZABETH** [GABBIE] & my sons ROBERT [GABBIE] & MOSES [GABBIE] after paying my sons **JONATHAN** [GABBIE] & JAMES [GABBIE] one shilling sterling & I do hereby appoint **THOMAS STRIBLING** & **JOSEPH GABEE** [GABBIE] to be executors to this my last will and testament in whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 6th day of February in the year of our Lord 1802.
