This Indenture made this fifth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety Eight, between Samuel Gardner of the State of Georgia and County of Jackson of the one part, and Joseph Humphris of said County & State of the other part, witnesseth, the aforesaid Samuel Gardner for and in consideration of the sum of twelve dollars to him in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained sold and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant, bargain sell and confirm unto the aforesaid Joseph Humphris his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land, situate lying & being in (the) County & State aforesaid, on a branch of the North fork of Oconee, bounded on the South by Benjamin Vermillion, and on the West by the said Humphris, and North westwardly by Millers land. Beginning at the said Humphris 13. oak x 3. Running S 4 W 15 Chains to a post Oak 3x - Thence N. 60 E. 19 Ch² to a pine 3x - Thence N. 23 W. 9 Ch² to a pine 3x Thence along Millers line to beginning for complement of thirty acres, be it more or less, agreeable to the above bounds
