County being of perfect sound Mind & Memory being be-
god do this 22nd Day of November in the year one thousand
seven hundred & ninety six Make & publish this my last
will & testament in manner following that is to say
first of all I commit my soul to the almighty god that
made it & my body to be buried in orderly & Decent
Manner — and that at the Discretion of my Executor
first of all I becommend all my just Debts to be
paid out of my Estate — second I give & bequeath unto

My Daughter Rachel sweetey five shillings
Third I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Margaret Thurington
Ten shillings of Cloth to wit two Cows & Calves & three heifers three year
old & bull & one year old heifer & the harness & sheep to be Equally
divided between the said Margaret & my Gran Daughter
Dolly Thurington I also I give & bequeath to my Daughter Margaret
a barrel & four Cairns I also I give & bequeath unto my
Daughter Dolly Thurington My bed & Linnen & the furniture
that belongeth to it & a clock over the door & a clock counterpane
two Pewter Dishes & half a dozen of Silver plates half a dozen of
spoons half a dozen of knives & forks two saws & a Cal & a two
year old heifer four Cairns and the other half of my wearing
one big pot & skillet one trunk one saddle one smothering down
& little wheel & spin, fork My tea scaldpan & two pair of Cuffs
and all other Part of my Estate not mentioned in this
will shall be & remain in the hands of my
Daughter Margaret ~~Thurington~~ & at her Dis-
posal & also Do constitute & appoint my
Daughter Margaret Thurington Executor of
this my last will & testament witness my
hand & seal the Day & Date above written
