Manumission Negro Richard from Jacob West

Know all Men by these presents that I Jacob West of Sussex County and State
of Delaware for divers good causes and considerations me thereunto moving do
manumit my Negro man Named Richard to be his own free man the first day
of January in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred and eight and for
him the said Negro Man named Richard to enjoy his freedom and all the bene-
fits of a free Negro or Mulatto in this State of Delaware or elsewhere after the
said first day of January 1808 and I the said Jacob West do hereby Warrant
and forever defend the said Richard West his freedom (he behaving himself well
according to the State, from the Claim or Claims of me the said Jacob West
and my Heirs Executors, Administrators and Assigns after the said day
above mentioned and I bind myself and each of my Heirs Executors and
Administrators to keep the said Negro man Richard from becoming a Charge
to the County of Wicomic whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal
this 13th day of March Eighteen hundred and four
Witness Shadrach Short Junr. Jacob West

Be it Remembered that on the 18th day of March 1807 personally appeared
before me Shadrach Short the Subscribing Witness to the foregoing or above
instrument of Manumission and being duly sworn on the holy Evangelists of
Almighty God saith that he saw Jacob West sign Seal and heard him ac-
knowledge the above instrument of Writing to be his Act and Deed and
that he this deponent signed his name to the same as a Witness sworn

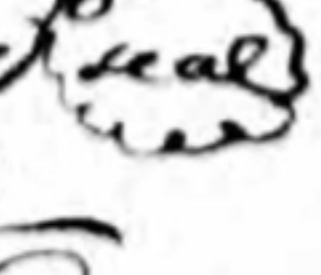
Deed Purnal Tatman from John Mulnise & wife

This Indenture Made this 18th day of November in the year of our
Lord One Thousand Eight hundred and Six Between John Mulnise

12/ of the County of Sussex and State of Delaware and Hesther his wife
of the one part and Purnal Tatman of the County and State aforesaid of
the other part, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one
hundred and five Dollars of Good and Current Money of the State aforesaid
to him in hand by the said Purnal Tatman or Secured to be paid
the receipt whereof the said John Mulnic and wife Hesther doth
hereby acknowledge and are selves therewith contented satisfied &
paid Hesther Grants bargained Sold Released enfeoffed Conveyed and
Confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell release
enfeoff Convey and Confirm unto Purnal Tatman his Heirs and
Assigns forever a certain Tract or part of a Tract of land in Sussex
County and in Hantioke Hundreds called and known by the name
of whose meetes and Bounds are as follows Beginning at a
marked Red Oak being a corner of the said Tatmans other Lands
and from thence running South Thirty one and a half degrees west
Ninety Nine perches to a Black Gum, thence North Seventy three
and a half degrees East Ninety seven perches to a post in the swamp,
thence North forty seven degrees East Twenty Two perches to a peach
Oak, then North fifty degrees West Eighty perches home to the place
of Beginning containing and laid out for Thirty Acres of land and
Swamp be the same more or less, To Have and To Hold
the Above described land and premises together with all the build-
ings Improvements Orchard fences waywaters Timbers wood and
underwood rents profits rights Claims and all the Hereditaments that
in any wise belongs to the said Lands unto the said Purnal Tatman
his Heirs and Assigns forever and further the said John Mulnic and wife
Hesther Doth hereby Covenant and Agree for themselves their Heirs Executors
Administrators to and with the said Purnal Tatman his Heirs Executors
Administrators or Assigns to Warrant and defend the above described lands
and premises from us our Heirs Executors Administrators and from
all manner of person or persons Claiming or to Claim from us or
under us our Heirs or Assigns and also from all person or persons
whatsoever laying any Claim or Claiming right title or interest to
the said land and premises above described In Testimony whereof
I the said John Mulnic and wife Hesther hath set our hands
and caused our Seal to be affixed the day and year above written

Know all Men by these presents that I Nathan Young of and being now the sole
Owner and having the entire and exclusive right & property of a Negro man named Dan
iel Twenty Seven years of Age or thereabouts do for certain good reasons me
thereunto Moving me after this date and from the present time manumit and
Also do Manumit the man Joseph after reserving his time till the ensuing Janu
ary for to be employed in my service the said Joseph is about in his Twenty
Third years of age and likewise I do Manumit Charles after reserving for
myself my heirs and assigns his service and the use and profits thereof untill the
said Term of four years and five Months are expired which at the Expiration
thereof Charles will be Twenty Three years of Age or thereabouts and also I do
Manumit Moses after reserving for myself my heirs and assigns his service and
the use and profits thereof untill the said Term of seven years and Ten Months
are expired from the date of this Manumit and as well the Charles that was
mentioned his time begins from the date of this Manumit and likewise
I do manumit Jean after reserving for myself my heirs and assigns her
service and the use and profits thereof untill the said Term of Nine years
and five Months are expired which at the expiration thereof Jean will be in
her Twenty Third year of Age or thereabouts, the said Jean time will begin
from the date of this manumit and like wise I Do Manumit Phillip
after reserving for myself my heirs and assigns his service and the use and
profits thereof untill the said Term of ten years and Nine Months are expir
