This Indenture made the 29th day of January in the Fifteenth
year of the Reign of George the Second King of Great Britain et^r And in the
Year of our Lord God One thousand Seven hundred and Forty One
Between Richard Colgate of Appoquinah Hundred and County of
Newcastle upon Delaware Planter and Bridget his wife of the one part
and Mary Hammond of the said place Widow of the other part Witnesseth
That the aforesaid Richard Colgate and Bridget his wife for and in
consideration of the sum of Five hundred pounds Current lawful Mo-
ney to them in hand well and truly paid by the aforesaid Mary Ham-
mond at or before the Sealing and Delivery hereof the receipt whereof
they do hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and for ever discharge
the said Mary Hammond her Heirs Executors Administrs and every of
them by these presents They the said Richard Colgate and Bridget his
Wife Granted Bargained sold aliened Enfeoffed and Conferred
and by these presents for themselves and their Heirs do fully & absolute-
ly Grant Bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the aforesaid
Mary Hammond her Heirs and Assigns Two several Tracts of Land
herein after described the one being commonly called or known by
the name of Elizabeth Gorritson's Dwelling Plantation being part of

334 a larger Tract called Red Cliff Situate lying and being in the Hundred
and County aforesaid on the South Side of Appoquinab Creek the other
Tract being commonly called or known by the name of Hollisville Gerritson
Deeds Land adjoining the South East Side of the first mentioned Tract
and is also part of the aforesaid Tract called Red Cliff and which said
first mentioned Tract is Bounded as follows, That is to say, Beginning

several Tracts of Land and premises and every part thereof unto her the
said Mary Hammond her Heirs and Assigns from and against him the
said Richard Colegate and his Heirs and against all and every other
person or persons whatsoever shall and will WARRANT and forever
Defend by these presents The Quittrents and payments to the Loan Office
aforesaid and the right of Possession of the aforesaid Elizabeth Gerrifton
only excepted And also that he the aforesaid Richard Colegate and
his Heirs from time to time and at all times hereafter shall and will
on the reasonable Request and at the proper Cost and Charges in the
