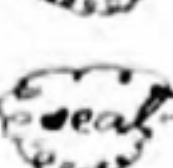

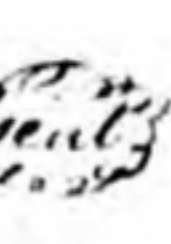

Manumission Negro Mose & others From Spencer Lacey.

Delaware State To all To Whom these Presents shall come Greeting Know ye that I Spencer Lacey of Superior County in the State of Delaware Being convinced of the greater Impropriety of holding my Fellow creatures in Slavery do hereby liberate free Manumitt In friendship the Negroes following to wit Negro Boy Mose aged Nineteen years To be free on Christmas day One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety three Negro Boy Sam aged Thirteen years to be free on Christmas day One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety Nine Negro Girl Nue to be free on Christmas day one thousand Eight hundred and Three aged Eight years Herby Acknowledge said Negroes discharged at the expiration of the above dates from all Claim of serving or Right of Property whatsoever from me my heirs Executors or Admin^{rs}. As Witness my hand and seal this Fifth day of December In the 5th year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety one.

Deed Phebe Massey From James Bryan & Uxor.

This Indenture made the twenty ninth day of October in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and Ninety five **Between** James Bryan of cedar creek hundred Superior County in the State of Delaware, Carpenter, and Nancy his wife of the one part, and Phebe Massey of Mississippi hundred Kent County in the State of Mdow of the other part **Whereas** a certain Andrew Fullington Obtained a proprietaries Warrant for 200 Acres of Land to be surveyed at and Near the place now called Shawnee Town which said Fullington afterwards assigned his Right of the aforesaid Warrant to a certain Bennet Bryan who was seized and possessed of 240 Acres of Land in consequence of the aforesaid warrant and being lawfully seized thereof Departed this life having first made his last will and Testament in Writing bearing date the fifth day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and Eighty seven and Remaining in the Registers office for the County of Sussex by which he the said Bennet Bryan did devise unto his three Sons Namely Shepard Bryan James Bryan (party hereto) and Johnathan

610 Bryan All his Lands to be Respectively Divided Between them which said Devises on the Ninth day of February
one thousand seven hundred and Eighty Eight entered into certain Bonds or Obligations made in Writing for a division
in the aforesaid Lands that were of Bennet Bryan Nominating and Appointing Nathl. Young Richd. Hays Isaac
Beauchamp William Bouroughs and Pemberton Earle Gentlemen of the said County of Sussex to go upon the
said Tristate Lands of Bennet Bryan dec'd; and View, Divide, and lay off, to each his their Respective allotment by
Meets and bounds. And the said Arbitrators taking on them the burden then Requested and going on the premises View
ing and maturely considering the same did make Partition and division therein laying off the said Premises
in three several Allotments or devidends allotting the North west Divided to Shepard Bryan the South East
Allotment to Jonathan Bryan and the Middle Allotment to Rachel Bryan (the widow) during her lifetime
and then to James Bryan as his Allotment all of which will appear by the Awards of said Arbitrators bearing
date February the sixteenth day of February One thousand seven hundred and Eighty Eight Reference thereto
being had. **Now this Indenture Witnesseth** that the said James Bryan and Nancy
his Wife for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and fifty Pounds Lawful Money to them in
hand paid and secured to be paid by the said Phoebe Mafsey **have** granted, bargained, sold, Alien'd, Rem-
ised, Released, infeofed, Conveyed, and confirmed, And by these presents they the said James Bryan and
Nancy his wife **do** grant bargain, sell, Alien Remise, Release, enfeof, Convey and Confirm unto
the said Phoebe Mafsey her heirs and Assigns forever, all the above Described Middle Dividend which was
laid off by the aforesaid Arbitrators as the Dower of Rachel Bryan and the share of James Bryan the Meets and
bounds of which are as follows viz **Beginning** at a Hickory bush in a line of Wm. Bouroughs's land and

agree, to and with the said Phoebe Mafsey her Heirs and Assigns by these presents that they the said James
Bryan and Nancy his Wife and their Heirs Executors and Administrators the hereby granted Premises
limited and bounded as hath herein been described and set forth with all the Appurtenances unto the said Phoebe
Mafsey her Heirs and Assigns forever Against the future Lawful claim of them the said James Bryan and
Nancy his Wife and their and each of their Heirs and against the Claim or Claims of all and every person
or person whosoever Lawfully Claiming or to Claim the Same by from or under him her them or any of them

611. or by from or under any other person, or persons, Rights, or Right, the Lord of the Soil Only Excepted shall and will
