Barnet Vanhert from John Coverdale

This Indenture made the sixth day of February in y^e Year of our Lord one thousand Seven
hundred and seventy one between John Coverdale son of Susanna of y^e County of Sussex yeoman of y^e
one part and Barnet Vanhert of y^e same County Yeoman of y^e other part. WHEREAS there is a small
parcel of Land situate lying and being in y^e County of Sussex a^s in y^e Forrest of Cedar Creek
hundred being part of a larger Tract of Land granted unto y^e a^s John Coverdale in y^e County of Sussex
a^s lying and being in y^e Great Neck being the East side of y^e a^s larger Tract Warrant granted
unto y^e a^s John Coverdale the thir day of October in Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty five
which said small parcel of Land is bounded as followeth. BEGINNING at a cornered oak standing
on y^e north west side of a Branch or Riverdam then North sixty five Degrees west Twenty Perches to a corner
white Oak of Land formerly Abraham Parsleys then along said Land North thirty and a half degrees
west sixty and a half perches to a corner Gum then by a Dividing Line South four and a quarter
Degrees west Two hundred Sixteen and a half perches to a corner Oak standing in a swamp a corner
of the Devedent then along the Lines thereof North Twenty one Degree East thirty two perches to a
corner Spanish Oak then North Twenty Nine Degree East forty perches Six feet to a corner white Oak
of Isaac Ingrams then North sixty five Degree East twenty seven and a quarter perches to a corner
Gum by y^e Branch or Main Dreen thence with a straight Line home to y^e first Boundary Con-
taining and laid off for about Fifty acres more or Less. Now this Indenture Witnesseth
that y^e said John Coverdale for and in consideration of y^e sum of seven Pounds Lawfull money
of this Government to him well and truly paid by y^e said Barnet Vanhert the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged by the said John Coverdale and himself fully satisfied contented &
paid and thereof and of Every part and parcel thereof do clearly acquit Exonerate and Discharge
the said Barnet Vanhert his heirs and Assigns forever by these presents He doth granted Bargained
sold alienated Enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do fully and absolutely grant Bar-
gain sell alien Enfeoff and confirm unto y^e said Barnet Vanhert his heirs and Assigns forever
the above recited fifty acres of Land more or Less Together with all & singular of ways Cou-
ments Hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging as in any wise appertaining
To have and to hold the said Land and Premises unto him the said Barnet Vanhert his heirs &
Assigns to y^e only proper use and behoof of him the said Barnet Vanhert his heirs & Assigns
forever & y^e John Coverdale doth hereby Covenant for himself and his heirs to and with the said
Barnet Vanhert his heirs and Assigns forever against y^e Lawfull Claim or Claims of him
the said John Coverdale his heirs and Assigns and all and Every other person or persons lawfully
Claiming by from or under him them or any of them shall and with warrant and force being
by virtue of these presents and in witness whereof the said John Coverdale hath hereunto set
his hand and seal the day and Year first above Written
