 Rebeca Thacher Grace Apdyck George Campbell and Rachel Camp-
 bell heirs and Legatees of the Reverend Daniel Thacher Decd of the
 one part and Benjamin Bryant of the County and State aforesaid
 of the other part Witnesseth that the said Jonathan Apdyck as at-
 torney aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five
 hundred Dollars to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
 knowledged hath bargained and sold released and Confirmed and
 by these presents doth bargain sell release and Convey to the said
 Benjamin Bryant all that tract or parcel of land situate lying
 & being in the County and State aforesaid on the Ocone River adjoining
 perkins Finly Mcbombs granted to John Paterson the 21st of Sept
 1784 and Conveyed by deed of Conveyance to James Finly and by the
 said Finly to the rev. Daniel Thacher and hereby Jonathan Apdyck
 as attorney in fact for the heirs and representatives of the Rev Daniel Thacher
 Decd to the said Benjamin Bryant his heirs and assigns Beginning at a Dog-
 wood corner on the east side of the Ocone River running N 30 E 75 chain
 89 links to a sweet gum x thence N 10 W 75 chain 89 links to a hickory x thence
 thence S 30 W 75 chain 89 links to a beach x on the River thence with the me-
 anders of said River to the beginning Dogwood x containing five hundred
 and twenty five acres agreeable to a plat and grant in the name of the
 said John Paterson reference being thereunto had will more fully appear
 Together with all and singular the appertinances thereunto belonging to
 the said Benjamin Bryant his heirs and assigns for ever and the said
 Jonathan doth farther covenant with the said Benjamin that he the said
 Jonathan Apdyck in behalf of himself and the heirs and representatives
 of the rev Daniel Thacher Decd. will hereby warrant and for ever defend the
 aforesaid tract of land & premises from him the said Jonathan Apdyck and
 from all the heirs and representatives of the said Daniel Thacher Decd and
 from all & every other person or persons whatsoever to the only proper use
 benefit & behoof of him the said Benjamin Bryant his heirs and assigns

as may appear by the above recited last Will and testament: our true and lawfull
Attorney for us and in our names and to our use to sell alien in fee off release convey and
confirm unto any person or persons whatsoever who may purchase all or any part or parcel
of the lands situate lying and being in the State of Georgia late the reverend Daniel
Thacher deceased as is given and bequeathed too us by the above recited last will and test-
ament of the above named Daniel Thacher Dec. and to have use and take all lawfull ways and
means in our names for the selling conveying and confirming all and singular the lands
hereditaments and appurtenances above mentioned or any part or parcel thereof to
the purchaser or purchasers giving and granting to our said Attorney full power and
lawfull authority for us or in our names all deeds and acquitances to give sign seal and
deliver and to do all other lawfull acts and things whatsoever for the better con-
firmation of the above said lands & premises or any part or parcel thereof as
fully in every respect as we our selves might or could do if we were person-
ally present ratifying and confirming all and whatsoever our said Attor-
ney shall in our names lawfully do or cause to be done in and about
the premises In witness where of we have to these presents set
