in the Consideration of the sum of Five hundred Dollars to him in  
hand paid at and before the sealing and Delivery of these presents the  
Receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged have this day Bargained & sold  
Released & Conveyed unto the said Benjamin Bryan by his and  
assigns all that tract or parcel of Land situate lying & being on the  
Waters of the North Fork of the Osage River on a Creek called  
Candler's Creek in the County aforesaid adjoining Blackwells Land  
and surveyed by Joseph V. Cunningham County Surveyor for the County aforesaid  
Containing seven hundred Acres be the same more or less beginning for  
the same at the Road on the East side of the survey near the  
Frontier Line thence South twenty East down across said Creek to a  
Post Oak corner thence South twenty west seventy Chains to Pine  
Corner thence North twenty west to Black Station on a Branch  
at the Old Hole Road which Branch is a corner thence along the Old  
Road including the School to the beginning together with all and  
singular Rights members & appurtenances thereto in any wise belonging  
So have & to hold the said Tract or parcel of Land to him his heirs  
and assigns and of the said James Ryke do warrant & forever defend  
the said Tract or parcel of Land from any claim or assigns  
if no further in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand &  
affixed my seal the date above written Done in the presence of
