

Georgia 3 This Indenture made this fourth day of March in the Year of our Lord
Hall County 3 One thousand Eight hundred and thirty nine between John B Braselton
3 of the one part and Stephen Bryant of the other part Witneseth. That the said
John B. Braselton for and in consideration of the sum of twenty dollars to him in hands
paid at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and conveyed and do by these
presents Grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Stephen Bryant his heirs
and assigns all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County afore-
said containing four acres more or less being a piece taken off of the tract that said
John B Braselton now lives upon formerly owned by William Spruce and sold as his
property at Sheriff's sale adjoining said Bryant. Bounded as follows. Beginning at
a Chesnut corner on said Braselton's East line made by himself running thence
East to a P.O. Corner, thence N. W. to a pine Corner also made by himself thence
South to the beginning Corners, to have and to hold said tract or parcel
of Land unto him the said Stephen Bryant his heirs and assigns together
with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances thereof to the
same in any manner belonging to his and their own proper use and
benefit and behoof forever in fee simple — And the said John B Braselton
for himself his heirs and Executors and Administrators the said bargained
premises, unto the said Stephen Bryant his heirs and assigns will warrant
and forever defend the right and title thereof against themselves and against
the claim of all other persons whatever in witness whereof the said John B
Braselton hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year above written

This indenture made and entered into the
25th day of May 1835 between Butler White of the County
of Hall and State of Georgia of the one part and
Mary White of Hall County and State aforesaid of the
other part witnesseth that I Mary White for and in
consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty
dollars to me in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged have bargained sold and confirmed and
by these presents do bargain sell and confirm unto said
Butler White a part of certain tract or parcel of land
situate lying and being in the County of formerly Guinn
now Hall County in the 9th District known by the name
for three hundred and eighty eight containing by estimate
seventy six acres be the same more or less a part of the
old tract before divided estimated at one hundred &
fifty two and 1/4 acres the sd Butler White line beginning
at the mouth of the main branch running through the
old plantation branch to be the line to its head or to
Crumptons line joining Whitworth and others with a
privilege of half the fishery belonging to the other part
of the tract of land which tract or parcel of land
with all and singular the right members and appur-
tenances thereunto belonging I do warrant and forever
