

This Indenture made & Confirmed the twentieth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & five Between Thomas Barron of the State of Georgia & County of Jackson of the one part & Richard Bryant of said State & County of said of the other part witnesseth that for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred fifty dollars now in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained & sold & firm by these presents do bargain & sell & set over to the said Richard Bryant out all singular that tract or parcel of land by information containing five hundred & a very little more or less the same being part of one thousand Acre granted to Thomas Barron by George Washington the North side of the boundary line adjoining land conveyed by said Barron to Benjamin Wharton Beginning on the line now marked between the last mentioned parties running N 35 W. to Hickory Corner thence South 55 W 100 Chaining to white Oak thence South 35 E to said Whartons line thence on said line to Beginning I have & hold all & singular the above described land & premises to the said Rich^d Bryant his heirs or assigns forever from the said Barron his heirs or assigns & also from all & every person or persons Just claims excepting only the Indians claim I Witness whereof the said Thomas Barron have hereunto set his hand & seal the date above written
