State of Georgia } This Indenture made this 17th day of July
Putnam County } in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and twenty two between James Bryant of the one part
and Joseph Turner of the other part both of the County and
State aforesaid Witnesseth that the said James Bryant for
in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars in hand
paid hath bargained sold and delivered unto Joseph Turner
his heirs & assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land
lying and being in the County and State aforesaid containing
fifty five acres more or less bounded as follows beginning at
a pine on Darby Holts & James Harts corner and running
along Holts line North 43 East 48 Poles to a post oak on
Holts line thence South 43 E 174 Poles to a stake on or in
the old district path thence along S. path South 43 West
48 Poles to a pine on said path on John H Walters
and Simon Holts corner and from thence to the beginning
to include the disputed part that George Brewer sold to
John Wynn to have the said tract of land with all and
every of their rights members thereto appertaining unto the
said Joseph Turner his heirs and assigns to their own proper
use and benefit forever in fee simple and the said James
Bryant doth and will warrant and forever defend the
right and title of the said land unto the said Joseph
Turner his heirs & assigns forever against the claim of
claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever In
Witness I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal

 between Christopher O Strong of the one part and Henry Bran-
 ham of the other part both of the County and State aforesaid
 Witnesseth that the said Christopher for and in consideration
 of the sum of Seventeen hundred and ninety four dollars to him
 by the said Henry in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged by the said Christopher that bargained and sold
 and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said
 Henry the following four tracts or parts of lots of land
 situate lying and being in the third district formerly Baldwin
 in now Putnam County the same being now in the occupa-
 tion of the said Christopher and all of which are adjacent
 and in constituting an entire tract would be bounded by Lyons
 Tomlin McBride & others each being of the following descrip-
 tion boundaries & contents To wit one hundred one and one
 fourth acres more or less being the North part of Lot one
 hundred and sixteen in the district aforesaid conveyed
 to the said Christopher by David Moore whose abutments
 and boundaries will more fully appear by reference to the
 record containing the deed of the said David to the said
 Christopher also thirty two and one tenth acres more or less
 being part of lot number one hundred and thirty four on the
 South West corner of said square in the district aforesaid
 beginning at a pine corner running North forty five degrees
 West Seventeen Chains and twenty five links to a lightwood
 stake the South forty five with Eighteen Chains sixty two
 links to a hickory corner then South forty five East Seventeen
 Chains twenty five links to a hickory bush then North forty
 five East Eighteen Chains sixty two links to the beginning
 corner conveyed by Henry Branham to the said Christopher
 also another piece of land conveyed by Abner Vealey to
 the said Christopher being part of lot number one hundred
 and thirty four in the district and county aforesaid containing
 thirteen acres more or less and one other piece containing seven
 acres more or less conveyed to the said Christopher by James
 Shackelford and being also part of lot number one hundred
 and thirty four in the county and district aforesaid both
 of which last mentioned tracts or pieces of land are
 adjacent to the one above described containing thirty two
 and one tenth acres and upon one or both of which the
 dwelling house & kitchen of the said Christopher stand to
 have and to hold the above four tracts or pieces of land
 to the said Henry his heirs administrators &c forever in
 fee simple together with all and singular the appurtenances
