 parcel thereof doth acquit and discharge have bargain
 and by this presents do bargain sell convey and confirm
 to the said Benjamin Whitfield and his heirs a certain
 tract or parcel of land Situate lying and being in the
 fourth District in Baldwin County bounded North
 East by lot Number 101 N. West lot N^o 76 South West by
 lot N^o 72 and South East by lot N^o 74 containing two
 hundred two and a half acres and known and distin-
 guished in the plan of said District by the number
 twenty five which said tract of land was drawn
 in the late Land lottery by John Reid of Franklin
 County with all and singular the rights and privileges
 to the same belonging together with the titles claims,
 Interests enolument and profits to the same belonging or
 in anywise appertaining to have and to hold the said
 tract of land and premises and every part thereof
 to the said Benjamin Whitfield and his heirs as a clear
 Indefeasible Estate Estate in fee simple absolute to all
 intents and purposes as can be held possessed enjoyed and
 the said John Bryan and Susanna his wife for
 themselves and their heirs that they will warrant and
 forever defend the legal right and title in and the said
 tract of land and premises to the said Benjamin
 Whitfield and his heirs against the lawful claims
 or claims of all and all manner of persons whatsoever In
