hand paid the receipt is hereby acknowledged hath bargained, sold and
delivered and conveyed and doth for himself his heirs, Executors administrators
or assigns bargain sell grant convey and deliver unto the aforesaid John
Shaw his heirs Executors administrators or assigns all that tract or parcel
of land situate lying and being in the County aforesaid wherein the
said Shaw now lives it being part of Lot No: Thirty two in the fifteenth
District of formerly Baldwin now Paper County Beginning at a pine
Stake then a direct line across the S^d lot to a pine Stake on the other
line, thence along the S^d line to a dogwood Stake thence across the said
lot again to a pine tree thence along the line to the beginning or first
mentioned ~~the~~ pine Stake corner containing fifty acres ~~more or less~~
be the same more or less. To have and to hold the said land and
premises with every part and particle thereon the afores^d Ephraim
Cunningham doth for himself his heirs Executors administrators & assigns
warrant and forever defend unto the aforesaid John Shaw his heirs Executors
administrators or assigns the aforesaid land with every part & particle thereon
or in any wise appertaining thereto in fee simple of the sum afores^d
against all manner of person or persons Right or rights in manner or form
