State of Georgia. This Indenture made the fourth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty-six, and in the Eleventh year of the Independence of the United States of America, Between William Bryant & his Wf. of the one part & William Barnett of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Bryant for and in consideration of the Sum of twenty pounds lawful money of the said State to them in hand well and truly paid by the said William Barnett at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged Have granted, bargained, sold Released and Confirmed, and by these presents DO grant bargain, sell, Release and Confirm unto the said William Barnett his heirs and assigns, All that tract of land lying in Richmond County containing Two hundred Acres butting & bounding as follows, Viz. Northwardly by a line unknown and Mathews land Eastwardly by Barnetts lands Southwardly by Zacharias land and Youngbloods land and Westwardly by Elles's land together with all and singular the rights members & appurtenances thereof whatsoever to the said tract of land being, belonging or in any wise appertaining and the Remainder, Reversions, rents, issues and profits thereof and of every part thereof To have & to hold the said Tract of land and all & singular the premises and appurtenances therunto belonging as aforesaid and every part thereof unto the said William

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Barnett his heirs and assigns to the only proper use Benefit
& Benefit of the said William Barnett his heirs and
assigns forever, and the said William Bryant and his Wife
and their heirs the Tract of land & premises aforesaid
and every part thereof unto the said William Barnett his
heirs and assigns against them the said William
Bryant and his Wife and their heirs and all and every
other person and persons whatsoever shall and will War-
rant and forever Defend by these presents In Witness
