bounded South west by Joseph Humphreys land east by Joseph Slade and Cable Howell
Land and on all sides by Vacant land at the time of surveying as will more fully appear
by a grant for the same to David O'Bryan dated on or about the sixteenth day of
November one thousand seven hundred and ninety three together with all and singular
the houses out houses Building and improvements rents issues Profits privileges commodities
and all the rights interest in Chaitance benefit claim and demand whatsoever to the said
land and all appertinances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to
hold the said tract of land and all and singular the premises above mentioned with
there and every of these Rights members and appertinances together with all and singular
writings touching or any wise concerning the same or any part thereof to the only proper
use benefit behoof of the said Lewis O'Bryan his heirs and assigns forever and the
