that the said Joseph Humphreys and Esther his wife for and in consideration of the sum of
twenty five Pounds Sterling money to them in hand well and truly paid at once before the
Sealing and delivery of these presents by the said John B. Humphreys the Receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged and themselves fully and intirely satisfied hath bargained sold and delivered
aliened, released and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant Bargain and sell alien release
and confirm unto the said John B. Humphreys his heirs and assigns forever all that tract of
or parcel of land containing one hundred acres situate and being in the County and State
aforesaid adjoining Bird Creek on the south side land surveyed for Githot Thomas
on the east and being the property of the said John B. Humphreys with all and singular the
right members and appertinences of the same and every part thereof or in any wise appertaining
to the same or any part thereof to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land containing
one hundred acres and all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said John
B. Humphreys his heirs and assigns forever the said Joseph Humphreys and Esther his
wife their heirs and assigns the said tract of land and every part thereof unto the said John
B. Humphreys his heirs and assigns against them the said Joseph Humphreys and
Esther his wife their heirs and assigns and against all and every other persons or persons what-
soever shall and will warrant and aid forever defend by these presents. In Witnes whereof

me hereunto moving have given and granted and by these presents do give grant and
confirm unto my Step Son John H. Hingsworth of Black Creek in the County and
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State aforesaid all and singular that tract of land containing one hundred and fifty acres granted unto David O'Bryan on the sixteenth day of November one thousand seven hundred and ninety three bounded west by land of Joseph Humphreys east by Joseph Slad and Gable Howell and on all other sides by land vacant at the time of surveying with all my house hold furniture bed and bedding, ploughs and axes hoes and scuticals with two Mares and seven head of cattle all my stock of hogs which contains of about twenty seven head, with all my kitchen furniture of all kind whatsoever to have and to hold all and singular the lands, goods and chattels, whatsoever of me Lewis O'Bryan to my step son John Hollingworth his heirs Executors administrators and assigns from henceforth to his own proper use & upon him, and therewith to do order and dispose at his will and pleasure his own proper goods and chattels freely and peaceable and quietly without any manner of title trouble or demand of me the said Lewis O'Bryan me or any other person whatsoever of all the premises title said Lewis O'Bryan planter have put my said step son John Hollingworth in full and peaceable possession by virtue hereof in witness whereof I the said Lewis O'Bryan have hereunto set my hand and seal this twentieth day of February one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight.
