YOU are forthwith to admeasure and lay out, or cause to be admeasured and laid out, unto *Andrew Berry* a Plantation, containing *Three hundred* Acres of Land, lying in *Anson* County, *On the N^o Side of the Cataba River On the S^o Side of M. Dowells Creek being the place he now lives on*

The said Land to be seated according to Rights, proved within Three Years, and entered with the Auditor before the Delivery hereof to the Surveyor: Observing His Majesty's Instructions, for running out of Lands; and a Plat and Certificate thereof, to return into the Secretary's Office, within Twelve Months from the Date hereof: And for so doing, this shall be your Warrant. Which Warrant may not be assign'd.
