Y O U are forthwith to admeasure and lay out, or cause to be ad-
measured and laid out, unto Lewis Franklin Bryant
a Plantation, containing
Two Hundred Acres of Land, in the
County of Dobbs On the South Side of Neuse River
Near the Westernmost Prong of falling Creek called back
bearing in his own line or Arthur Forts
and joining Joseph Pipkin and
William Crawford's lines

Observing his Majesty's Instructions for running out Lands ; Two just and fair Plans whereof, with a proper Certificate annexed to each, you are to return into the Secretary's Office, within Twelve Months from the Date hereof : And if the Warrantee shall not within Eighteen Months from the Date hereof, take out a Patent for the said Land, this Warrant, and all Proceedings thereon, shall be void and of no Force ; and the said Land shall be deemed vacant and free to be taken up by any other Person.
