 Othrumfeld (This indenture made the 27th day of July, in the
 third year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George
 the Third &c. Between Henry M^cGulloch of the Kingdom of Great
 Britain &c. of the one part Esquire, and Charles Brumfield, of
 Johnston county, in the province of North Carolina, of the other part,
 Planter -

Now, this indenture witnesseth, that for and in consideration
 of the sum of 24 pounds Virginia money in hand paid by
 the said Char. Brumfield to the said Henry M^cGulloch, the
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged - The said Henry
 M^cGulloch hath for himself and his heirs given, granted,
 bargained, sold and confirmed, and by these presents hath
 given &c. unto the said Charles Brumfield his heirs and
 assigns forever, all that piece and parcel of land, lying and
 being in the county of Johnston aforesaid, being part of
 the Tract No. 12. Beginning at a red oak near a branch
 running thence No. 58 N. at 140 poles crossing Beaver Dam Creek,
 in all 192 poles, to a white oak, the So. 37, N. 228 poles to a
 pine, thence So. at 80 poles, crossing the creek again in all
 120 poles to a white oak, thence No. 68 N. 247 poles to a stake,
 thence to the beginning, containing in the whole 320 acres
 of land - To have and to hold to him the said Charles
 Brumfield, his heirs and assigns forever (For what's left
 out, look Deed page 87)
