1756.

572 two acres of land in Johnston County on both sides of Culhman's
Branch Beginning at a white oak then North 140 poles to a
pine then East 140 poles to a red oak then South 140 poles to a poplar
in said Branch then west 140 poles to the first Station Dated
4th day of July 1760.
