of Land in said County on Pearson's creek Betw
een Robert Deans & Reminers; line Dtz Beginning
containing 103 Acres more or less with the appurten
ances lying & being in Beginning at two Post
oaks on William Beatty's line thence northward
Run 100⁰ 00⁰ poles to a black oak then
So 70⁰ E 83⁰ poles with Reminers line to 2 White
oaks then N 20⁰ E 200 poles to a Stake on Rob
Deans line thence to the Beginning lying & being
as aforesaid with their Sever. of these Rights
members & appurtenances what so ever the
reversion & Reversions Remain'd & Remain
ers of all & Singular the Land, Tenements, Rents
& Premises hereby Granted or intended to be
