

The Shaws corner & running thence up the said line
of the Creek South 40. degrees East 192. poles to a post
near John Rutleges line crossing a branch thence nearly
with his line North 7. degrees East 190. poles to a black oak
crossing said creek thence the same course 60. poles to
a Stake on Jeremiah Elders line thence with or near
line West 145. poles to a Stake on said Shaws line crossing

in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
and Ninety Six between William Fowler of the
one part and Abraham Collins of the other part
both of the county of Lincoln & State of North Carolina
witnesseth that for and in consideration of the
sum of Fifty pounds current money of the State aforesaid

and paid before the Signing & Delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged That granted bargained sold aliened conveyed & confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien convey & confirm unto the saids Abraham Collins his heirs and assigns for ever a certain tract or parcel of Land in said county of Benson's Creek Between Robert Myers & Remins's lines Viz Beginning at two post oaks on William Bealys line thence with said line South 20. W. 200. poles to a black oak thence S. 70. E. 33. poles with Remins's line to two white oaks thence N. 20. E. 200. poles to a Stake on Robert Myers line thence to the beginning containing one hundred & thirty acres More or less With the appurtenances lying & being as aforesaid with their Jewry of their rights Members & appurtenances who soever and the Reversion & Reversions Remainders & Remainders of all and Singular the lands Tenements Hereafter to be granted or intended to be granted and of every part and parcel thereof (and all rents issues Services & profits to them or any of them or any part or parcel of them or any of them incident belonging or appertaining and also all Jewry the Estate & Estates Rights titles claims interest & Demands whatsoever of him the said William Fowler of or unto the said Land tenements hereditaments & Premises whatsoever To have Hathold the said Land tenements Hereditaments & Premises here by granted with their appurtenances to the said Abraham Collins his heirs & assigns for ever to the Only proper use and behoof of him the said Abraham Collins for ever And the said William Fowler for himself his heirs Executors & Admin^{rs} shall and will at all times War-rant and for ever defend the said premises to the said Abraham Collins his heirs & assigns against all lawfull claims or Demands whatsoever whereby the above mentioned premises might or may be affected or incumbered Contrary to the true intent and meaning of these presents In witness whereof the said William Fowler hath hereunto set his hand & seal the day & year first above written being the XXII^d of Americas Independence
