

48 Charles Moore: 300 Acres Mecklenburgh on both sides of Tyger river generally known by the name of Lawsons creek Beginning at a white oak in Hugh Lawsons line on the N side of the river and runs thence $S^{30}W^{46}$ po: to a small red oak in his own line then with said line crossing the river $S^{70}W^{40}$ po: to a white oak his own corner then with his other line N^{30} po: to a white oak then $N^{82}W^{346}$ po: to a white oak then $S^{30}E^{300}$ po: to a white oak in Hugh Lawsons line then with said line $S^{40}E^{290}$ po: to the Beginning dated 26th April 1767.

49 David Davis: 200 Acres Mecklenburgh on both sides the main North forks of Tyger river joining Jonathen Newmans upper Line Beginning at a post oak on the south side of said fork thence $N^{24}E^{180}$ po: crossing the creek to a pine thence $S^{66}E^{180}$ po: to a crooked red oak then $S^{34}W^{148}$ poles closing the creek to a black oak in Jonathen Newmans line then $S^{37}W^{48}$ po: passing said Newmans corner to a small white oak then to the Beginning dated 26th October 1767.

50 Joseph Alexander: 200 Acres Mecklenburgh on both sides a branch of the south branch of the N fork of Tyger river about half a mile above Alexander Mc Carters land Beginning at a red oak on the south side of said branch thence E^{180} po: to a post oak then N^{180} po: crossing the branch to a black oak then W^{180} po: to a stake near the branch then S^{180} po: to the Beginning dated 26th October 1767.

51 Joseph Alexander: 200 Acres Mecklenburgh on the N side of Tyger river on both sides of Wards creek joining John Millers upper line Beginning at a black oak said Millers corner then $N^{09}E^{180}$ po: up the creek to a red oak and pine then $S^{81}E^{180}$ po: crossing the creek to a white oak on the bank of a small branch then $S^{09}W^{180}$ po: to a stake near a branch thence $N^{81}W^{180}$ po: crossing the creek with said Millers line to the Beginning dated 26th October 1767.
