

48 Charles Moore: 300 Acres Mecklenburgh on both sides of Tyger river generally known by the name of Lawsons creek Beginning at a white oak in Hugh Lawsons line on the N side of the river and runs thence S^o 30 W^t 46 po: to a small red oak in his own line then with said line crossing the river S^o 70 W^t 40 po: to a white oak his own corner then with his other line N^o 30 po: to a white oak then N^o 82 W^t 346 po: to a white oak then S^o 30 E^t 300 po: to a white oak in Hugh Lawsons line then with said line S^o 40 E^t 290 po: to the Beginning dated 26th April 1767
