 acknowledged by them the said Edward Lucy and Jane his wife hath granted
 bargained and sold alien and comprised and by these presents doth grant bargain
 and sell alien and comprise unto the said Robert Bratton his heirs and assigns
 for ever all that Mynage Land or parcel of Land situate lying and being
 in the County and Province aforesaid on the south side of Catawba River and
 on the head waters of a Branch of Turkey Creek near Robert Brattons land
