 and sold Alien and Confirmed  
 by these presents do bargain and sell  
 Alien and Confirmed unto the said Thomas  
 Nation his heirs and assigns forever all that  
 certain tract or parcel of Land situate  
 lying in the County and State aforesaid upon  
 the West branch of Saw back on the East side  
 of the Catawba River beginning at a corner  
 White Oak of John Daves thence then with  
 Daves line  $77 \frac{1}{2}$  pole to a pine then  
 with Daves line  $113 \frac{1}{4}$  pole to  
 corner then and the same course continuing  
 38 pole to an Oak sapling then  $62 \frac{1}{2}$  pole  
 to a 100, then with Joseph Marx line  $110 \frac{1}{2}$   
 76 pole to his corner for here Henry then  
 along the other line  $76 \frac{1}{2}$  pole to a stake  
 then north 70 pole to a pine then  $25 \frac{1}{2}$  pole  
 to the beginning containing 150 acres of  
 Land or more further appears by John  
 M. Smith Shermonds deed to John M. the bearing  
 date 9th day of November 1764 and the
