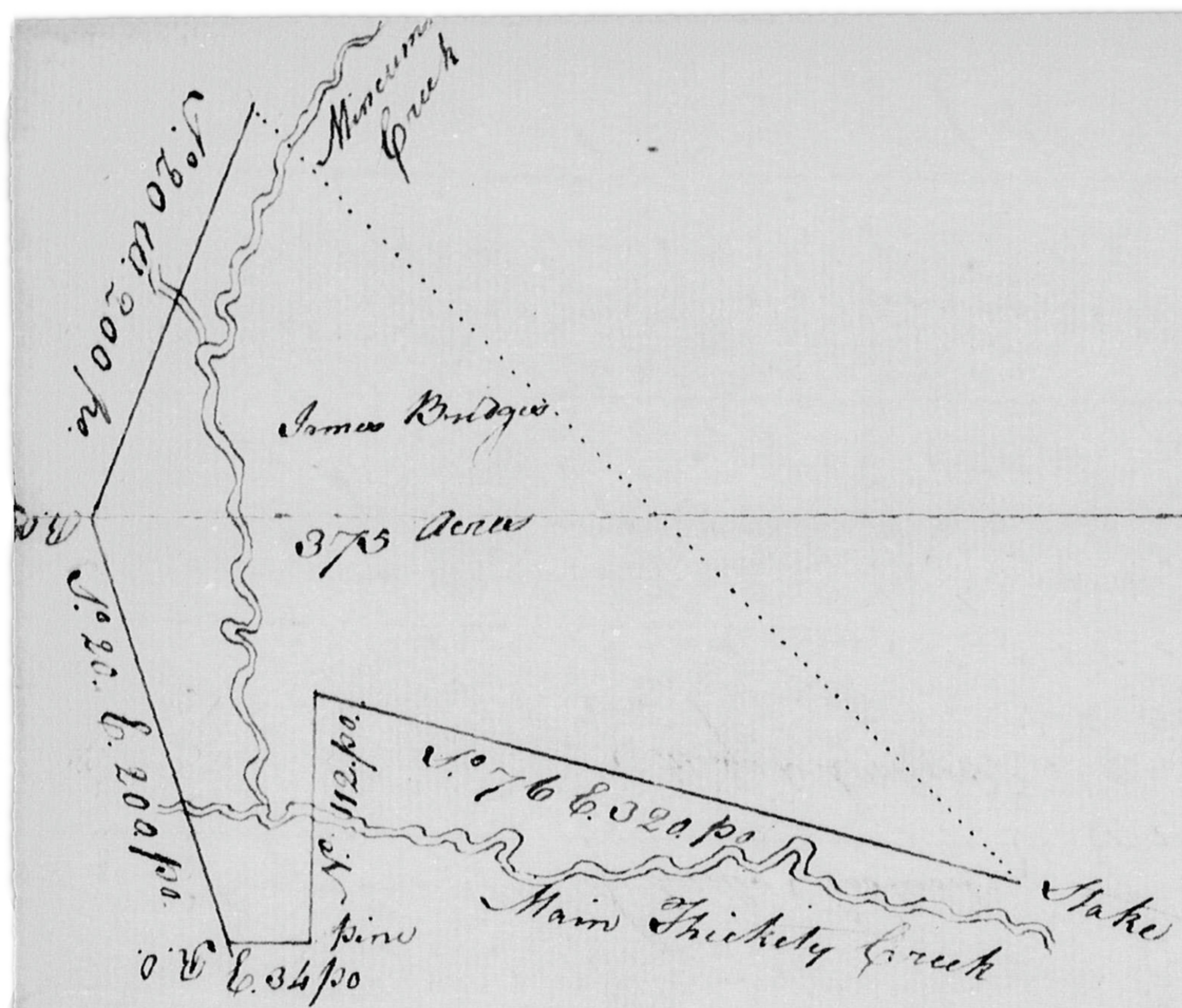

407 **Arthur Mabson**: 92 Acres New Hanover on Both sides of Long Creek Beginning at a sweet gum James Thomas and Joseph Lamb's corner running thence along Lamb's line $N^{\circ}50 E^{\circ}160$ po: to an ash Lamb's corner near Rowan's line thence $N^{\circ}40 W^{\circ}60$ po: to a hickory on David Jones' line thence $S^{\circ}71 W^{\circ}220$ po: to a pine on Anthony Burdeaux's line thence $S^{\circ}8 E^{\circ}18$ po: to Burdeaux's corner pine thence $S^{\circ}100$ po: to Peter Lamb's line thence $N^{\circ}73 E^{\circ}130$ po: to the first Station dated 26th October 1767.
