 to him the said Upton Byron his heirs and assigns for ever all that tract
 of land in P. County being of 3 tracts. The first tract granted to Robt. Isaac Jan. 1. 30.
 & granted to the Bigbams. And by sundry conveyances to John Taylor Deced^t
 the said John Taylor to his son James Taylor & all in the Clerk's Office &c.
 & by a survey on Lewis line Robt. Bigbams old corner then N. 111.
 & 112. poles on P. Bigbams line then N 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ 94 poles to a B. Jack on
 & Bigbams to Alice Green. then with the various courses of P. road 145 poles
