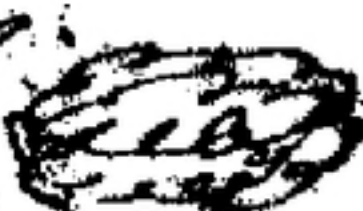


Indenture made the 25th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy two between Jack Smith of the county of Mecklenburg & State of N^o Carolina of the one part & John Byrom of the county & State afo^r of the other part witnesseth that for consideration of the sum of sixty pounds N^o Carolina currency paid by the s^d John Byrom in hand to the s^d Jack Smith the receipt & payment whereof is hereby acknowledged — the s^d Jack Smith hath given granted bargained & sold & by these presents do give grant bargain sell & confirm unto the s^d John Byrom his heirs & assigns a certain tract piece or parcel of land situate lying & being in the county of Mecklenburg & State of N^o Carolina on the west side of Sugar-creek joining John Tyler on the west & joining the s^d Jack Smith on the s^e & being part of the s^d Smiths plantation beginning at a W.O. running thence N. 55th W. 2nd pt to a B.O. then N. 77th W. 36th pt to a W.O. then ~~N. 35th W. 100th pt~~ to a W.O. then N. 35th W. 24th pt to a B.O. then N. 20th E. 40th pt to a Hickory thence to the beginning corner containing by estimation sixty two acres be the same more or less — to have & hold the above granted & sold piece of land with the appurtenances & all rights privileged & improvements to the same in any wise belonging & appertaining to him the s^d John Byrom & to his heirs & assigns forever & the s^d Jack Smith for himself his heirs & assigns doth hereby covenant & agree to & with the s^d John Byrom that he the s^d John Byrom his heirs & assigns shall & may forever hereafter have hold occupy possess & enjoy the before granted ~~land~~ premises & every part & parcel thereof without the least molestation of any person whatsoever & to be free & clear of all manner of incumbrances whatsoever & the s^d Jack Smith doth oblige himself his heirs exec^s & adm^s to warrant & forever defend the above lands & premises to him the s^d John Byrom & to his heirs & assigns forever against any just or lawful claim of all & every person & persons whatsoever In Witness whereof the s^d Jack Smith hath hereunto set his hand & seal the day & year first above written signed sealed & delivered in presence of Godfrey Williamson — Upton Byrom

Indenture made this day of April 1793 between Mrs. William of the one part & Paul Baeringer of the other part Witnesseth that the s^d William for & in consideration of the sum of _____ to him in hand paid by the s^d Paul Baeringer the receipt whereof he the s^d William doth confirm the s^d William hath granted bargained & sold & by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the s^d Paul Baeringer all that Messuage & tenement all those lands & lying & being in the County of Mecklenburg upon the waters of Mallard Creek beginning at a large W.O. running a branch the beginning corner of the old survey running thence N. 55th W. 100 poles to a Hickory the other corner of s^d tract thence with the line of the same N. 19th E. 100 poles to a Black Jack near a corner of the corner thence with the dividing line of s^d survey S. 30th E. 40 poles to a large Hawthorn oak s^d 40 poles the other corner on the bank of a branch to his back in the line of s^d tract thence with s^d line S. 15th E. 150 poles to a large B.O. a corner of the old survey on the west side of the wagon Road that goes from J^o M^o Will^o Henderson to the Crop Road thence N. 57th W. 100 poles to the beginning containing by Estimation 107 Acres also one other tract or parcel of land situate lying & being in the County of Mecklenburg joining the above mentioned tract beginning at a W.O. in the other tract running thence S. 02nd W. 60 poles to a B.O. thence the beginning of the old survey thence with the line of the old tract N. 55th W. 100 poles passing the other corner Hickory to the old survey 10 poles to a Stake in a W. O. line thence S. 07th W. 10 poles to a Stake thence N. 00th E. 105 poles to a B.O. said to be 106
