& Province of the other Part witnesseth that the said Peter and Mary
Guy Kendall for and in Consideration of the sum of five shillings Proclama
tion money to them in hand paid by the said Alexander Love at & before the
Sealing and Delivery of these Presents the Receipt Whereof is hereby ac
knowledged & hath granted bargained and sold & by these Presents doth give
Bargain and sell unto the said Alexander Love all that tract of Land or Parcels
of Land containing Two hundred and fifty acres situate lying and being
in the County of Mecklenburgh in the said Province on a South side Spring
Branch of Sinking Creek near their own Land Beginning at a Large Whitethorn
on the South Side of the said Creek & running N. 72 W. 145 Poles to a Red Oak
thence South 70 W. to a Red Oak 140 Poles thence South 10 E 1720 Poles by
going to the fork of the Water of Sinking Creek to a Red Oak thence
South 39 East 200 to a Black Oak tree near Samuel Dawson's Line thence to the
