 in the Province of North Carolina of the One Part and Alexander Love
 of the said County & Province of the Other Part Witnesseth that for and
 in consideration of the sum of Forty Pounds Proclamation money to
 the said Peter Kuykendal in hand Paid by the said Alexander Love at &
 before the sealing and Delivery of these Presents the Receipt Whereof he doth
 hereby acknowledge and though doth Discharge & acquit the said
 Alexander Love his heirs & Executors by these Presents they the said
 Peter and Mary Kuykendal have given granted bargained sold aliened
 Released and Conformed and by these Presents do Grant sell and Con-
 firm unto the said Alexander Love in his actual Possession now being
 by Virtue of a bargain and Sale to him thereof made for one whole
 year by Underwritten bearing date the day next before the date hereof
 and by force of the Statute for Transferring new into Possession and to
 his heirs & assigns for ever all that Tract or Parcel of Land contain-
 ing two hundred and fifty Acres lying and situated in the County of
 Mülhburg in N^o Carolina on a South head Spring branch of fishing
 Creek near their own Land Beginning at a Large White Oak on the
 South side of said Creek & Running N^o 72 W^o 14 50 Poles to a Red Oak
 thence South 70 W^o to a Red Oak 140 Poles thence South 80 W^o 190
 Poles crossing below some forks of the Waters of Turkey Creek to a
 Red Oak thence South 59 East 200 Poles to a black Oak near Capt.
 Davison's Line thence to the Beginning granted by Patent bearing Date
 April 6th 1706 Numbered 30 unto the said Peter Kuykendal M^o Tryon Esq^r
 Lieutenant Governor for the time being and all buildings Orchard
 Improvements ways waters Profits Commodities Hereditaments & Appur-
 tenances Whatsoever thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining and
 the Reversion Remainders Rents Issues & Profits thereof and also all
 the Estate Right Title Interest Property or Claim of them the said
 Peter and Mary Kuykendal either in Law or Equity of us and to the
 said Premises and all Writings touching or concerning the same
 To Have and To Hold the said Tract or Parcel of Land as above
 bounded and all the Premises hereby granted & Released wth all
 appurtenances unto the said Alexander Love his heirs and
 assigns forever and to the only Proper use and behoof of him the
 said Alexander Love his heirs and assigns forever and the said
 Peter and Mary Kuykendal for themselves their heirs Executors
 & Admin^{rs} do Promise covenant and agree to & wth the said Alexander
 Love his heirs & assigns by these Presents that they the said Peter &
 Mary Kuykendal are at the time of the sealing of these Presents seized
 of an Absolute Estate of Inheritance in the simple of and in the Prem-
 ises hereby granted and Released and that they have lawful
 authority to grant and convey the same to the said Alexander Love
 his heirs and assigns in manner and form aforesaid and that
 the said Premises are now clear & free off and from all former

and sold and by these Presents do Grant bargain and sell unto
the said Robert McLeod all that Tract or Parcel of Land containing
by Estimation three hundred acres be the same more or less situate
-ate lying and being in the County of Mucklenburgh in the said Pro-
-vince on the East side of the Catawba River on both sides of
Fools Road joining David McLeod, Sellers and Hugh Keatey
lines beginning at a White Oak and Running North 10 1/4 Pole
to and with Sellers line to a Black Oak Sapling corner to David
McLeod then with his line East 200 Pole to his corner a Hickory
then South 10 1/4 Pole to a White Oak Sapling on Hugh Keatey
line and thence West 200 Pole with Hugh Keatey line to the be-
-ginning being Part of a Tract of six hundred and forty acres
of Land granted unto the said Francis Keatey by Patent bearing
Date the 21. day of December A.D. 1763 And all Houses Buildings
