

This Indenture made this 20th day of March 1798 between
 Robt Alexander of Lincoln County State of Maryland & John Sumpter
 of Mecklenburg County in State of the one part And Andrew Lewis
 of Mecklenburg County State apts of the other part Witnesseth that
 the s^d Robt Alexander & John Sumpter for & in consideration of the
 sum of Sixty pounds New-Currency in hand paid the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged Do for themselves their heirs executors
 give grant sell & confirm unto the s^d Andrew Lewis his heirs
 & assigns for ever a piece or parcel of land lying in s^d County of
 Mecklenburg on the Cataraugus river including four Islands and
 River Pyramony at a Branch on the bank of s^d River & runs N^o 80
 W 15 ps to a Rock in the River then down the river S 31 W 120 ps
 to a Rock in s^d River then S 10 E 30 ps to a Holley on the bank of
 the River then S 78 E 26 ps to a B.O. Luster's branch corner then
 S 41 E 120 ps to a B.O. And s^d River corner then N 53 E 104
 ps to a B.O. s^d Lewis's other corner then N 67 W 128 ps to a
 Person on the bank of the river then up s^d River to the River
 Containing 100 acres of land & water be it more or less Which
 s^d tract was granted to Sumpter by s^d State the 17th Nov^r 1792
 & sold by the Sheriff of Mecklenburg to s^d Robt Alexander & deed
 made the 12 June 1797 - all duly of record -
 That s^d piece or parcel of land with all ways woods water & every
 other appurtenance thereto belonging or appertaining they the s^d Robt
 Alex^r & John Sumpter have hereby sold set over & confirmed to the s^d And^r
 Lewis his heirs & assigns for ever And the s^d Robt Alex^r & John Sumpter
 doth hereby for themselves their heirs executors & promises that they
 their heirs executors shall & will warrant & for ever defend the s^d land
 free from all legal claims of all & every person whatever unto
 the s^d Andrew Lewis his heirs & assigns forever In Witness
 whereof the s^d Robt Alex^r & John Sumpter have hereunto set their
 hands & seals the day & year first above written
