This Indenture made this day of 1801 Between Robt Davidson Not.
Brisson William Davidson & Son W. H. Alexander of the one part being
Exors of the Davidson decd & Hugh Brisson of the other part Witnesseth
that whereas the sd Davidson in his life time did sell to the sd Hugh Brisson
33 acres being that part of sd Davidsons 100 acre Grant which included
a part of sd Brissons 3 fields & patch near his house for the average
expense of procuring sd Grant viz £3:5-0 which sd 33 acres were
measured & marked by W. H. Knite & J. A. Muck as per plat by the express
order of sd Davidson And whereas sd Davidson finding death
approaching desired to have all his contracts fulfilled did on the
31st of July 1800 by a Codicil now of record to his will expressly
order his Exors to make sd H. Brisson a deed for 33 acres on receiving
£3:5-0 We therefore the Exors of sd Davidson do
acknowledge the rec^d of sd £3:5-0 & therefore to give all the
relief in our power do give grant & convey unto the sd
Brisson the aff^d 33 acres Beginning at a w.o. now dead being an
old corner to the land sd Brisson now lives on then going a small
branch with his sd old line S41 W88 po to his other old corner
a large B.O. near his fence then N63E 70 po with Devests line
to his corner R.O. then his other line N21 po to a stake just over
sd branch his other corner then N49 W10 po to sd by crossing w.o.
then with sd Brissons old giving line S88W 190 po say leaving
branch & 3 fields to J. B. Laphins close to his fence then with
sd fence N74 E 36 po to a R.O. sapling then going a small glade
S88E 60 po to a small p.o. corner on sd Devests old line then
with his line S34 W 10 po to his corner a small hick sapling
& then with sd Devests old line to the Beginning containing
33 acres more or less being part of sd Davidsons 100 acre Grant
of record nearly the half of sd 33 acres is now & has long been
in the possession & under the actual occupancy of sd Brisson
All which described land with every thing thereon or thereto
belonging or appertaining We the sd Exors do hereby warrant
& defend to him the sd H. Brisson his heirs & assigns for ever in
as full a manner as we by law are enabled but no further
In Witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands & seals
