Broad River, above John Warters Land, Beginning at a small hickory
by the River Bank on the N. side of the River, lower end of the bottom of
Pines thence N. 180 poles to a Red Oak, thence crossing the River W. 100
poles to a Red Oak, thence N. 180 poles to a stake, thence to the beginning
Dated 30 October 1765 Wm. Tryon.

88. William Lofton 200 Mecklenburgh On both sides of the Six mile fork,
Beginning at a hickory on Donaldsons line and runs thence along John Sharn
line S. 44 E. 220 poles to a Post Oak by Courtneys branch, thence N. 75 W. 100
