 to pay and satisfy Stephen Young for a Judgment the S. Stephen  
 Young Obtained against Sam: Bryant, have given, Granted,  
 Bargained and Sold unto the S. Denny Williams Williams a cer-  
 tain Tract or parcel of Land Lying and being in the County  
 aforesaid and Bounded as follows (To wit) Beginning at John  
 Varonis corner at a pine Running North one hundred and Sixty  
 Pole to a pine & Black Oak thence East two hundred pole to a  
 Black Oak thence South one hundred & Sixty poles to a Black  
 Oak thence a Direct line to the beginning Containing by Esti-  
 mation two hundred acres be the same more or less, to have  
 and to hold the said bargained premises with every Benefit  
 Privilege & appurtenance thereunto belonging to the S. Denny  
 Williams his Heirs and assigns for ever in witness whereof I the  
 S. J. Samuel Westray as Sheriff have hereunto set my hand
