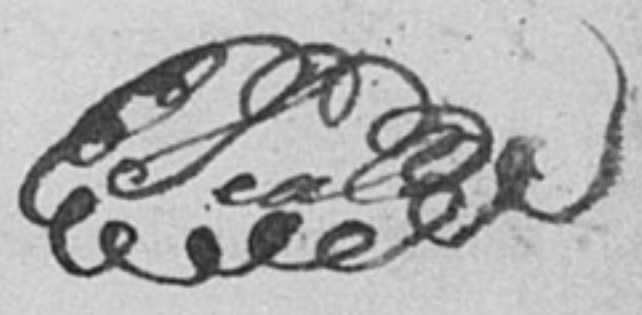

This Indenture made this Twentieth of June in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred & three Between Edward Dyces of the one part & Mattheie Swizea of the other part both of the State of North Carolina & County of Puttersonford Witnesseth that for & in consideration of the sum of 100 Dollars to the S^r Dyces in hand paid by the S^r Swizea hath granted Bargained sold Conveyed and Confirmed unto the S^d Swizea one certain Tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred Acres Lying & being in the County aforesaid on the Waters of Sandy Run the North side ^{of} main Broad River lying on the Sinkhole Branch Beginning on a Hickory his own Corner Running thence South Seventy three ^{to} a ^{pole} Pine thence South 18 E. 56 poles to a pine on John Walkers line thence S. 15 E. a few poles to a pine Walkers Corner thence West another ^{square} of S. East one hundred & sixty poles to a post Oak on S. line thence S. 14 poles to a stake in the Speculators line thence S. 60 W. 75 poles to a post Oak the Speculators Corner thence W. 117 poles to a

 the S^o Side of the River near Potters line thence S^o Thirty
 Seven East one hundred & fifty two poles to a Spanish Oak
 thence S^o fifty three W^t one hundred & six poles crossing Green
 River to a stake thence S^o thirty seven W^t one hundred &
 fifty two poles to a stake thence crossing the River to the
 Beginning Which I the afores^d John Mills do Warrant
 & Defend from all persons Whatsoever & by these presents
 I do bind myself my Heirs Executors Administrators &
