State of north Carolina To all to whom these presents shall come greeting
Sheweth that we for and in consideration of the sum of fifty shillings for
every hundred acres hereby granted paid into our treasury by Rachel Swersey have
given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the
said Rachel Swersey a tract of land containing thirty acres lying and being
in our County of Rutherford on the waters of Sandy Run on the west side
of his old plantation beginning on a Chermet William Burnett begin-
ing corner running thence thence with said line north one hundred
and fifty nine poles to a Spanish oak on the Speculators line thence
with said line south sixty west sixty nine poles to a post oak
on said line and on Williams tortons thence with said line South
twenty five east one hundred and forty poles to the beginning Entered
the 18th of January 1700 as by the plate hereunto annexed doth
appear together with all woods waters mines minerals hereditaments
and appertenance to said land belonging or appertaining to hold to the
said Rachel Swersey his heirs and assigns forever yielding and pay-
ing to us the sum of money yearly or otherwise as our General Assem-
bly from time to time may direct provided always that the
said Grants shall cause this Grants to be registered in the regis-
ters office of said County of Rutherford within six calendar months

from the date hereof otherwise the same shall be void and of no effect
 in testimony whereof we have caused these our letters to be made

This Indenture made the twenty fifth day of September in
 the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety
 eight between Solomon Taber and cartton Linsey of the other
 part both of the county of Rutherford and State of North Carolina
 witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds good
 and lawful money of the aforesaid to the said Solomon Taber in
 hand paid by the said cartton Linsey before the sealing and
 delivering of these presents the receipts and paymests whereof
 in hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold alien enoff
 and confirmed unto the said cartton Linsey and by these presents
 doth grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the cartton Linsey
 his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land lying
 and being in the said county of Rutherford and State of North Car-
 olina containing fifty acres and bounded as follows beginning on
 the north fork of white oak at a black oak Larus grant corner
 a pine thence with said grant line south forty poles to a black
 oak thence east twenty poles to a black oak thence north thirty
 two poles to Chestnut thence east eighty poles to a poplar thence
 north fifty poles to black Gum thence west one hundred and forty
 eight to a black Oak thence south forty two poles to a stake
 in grant grant line thence with said east one hundred and twenty
 poles to the Beginning
