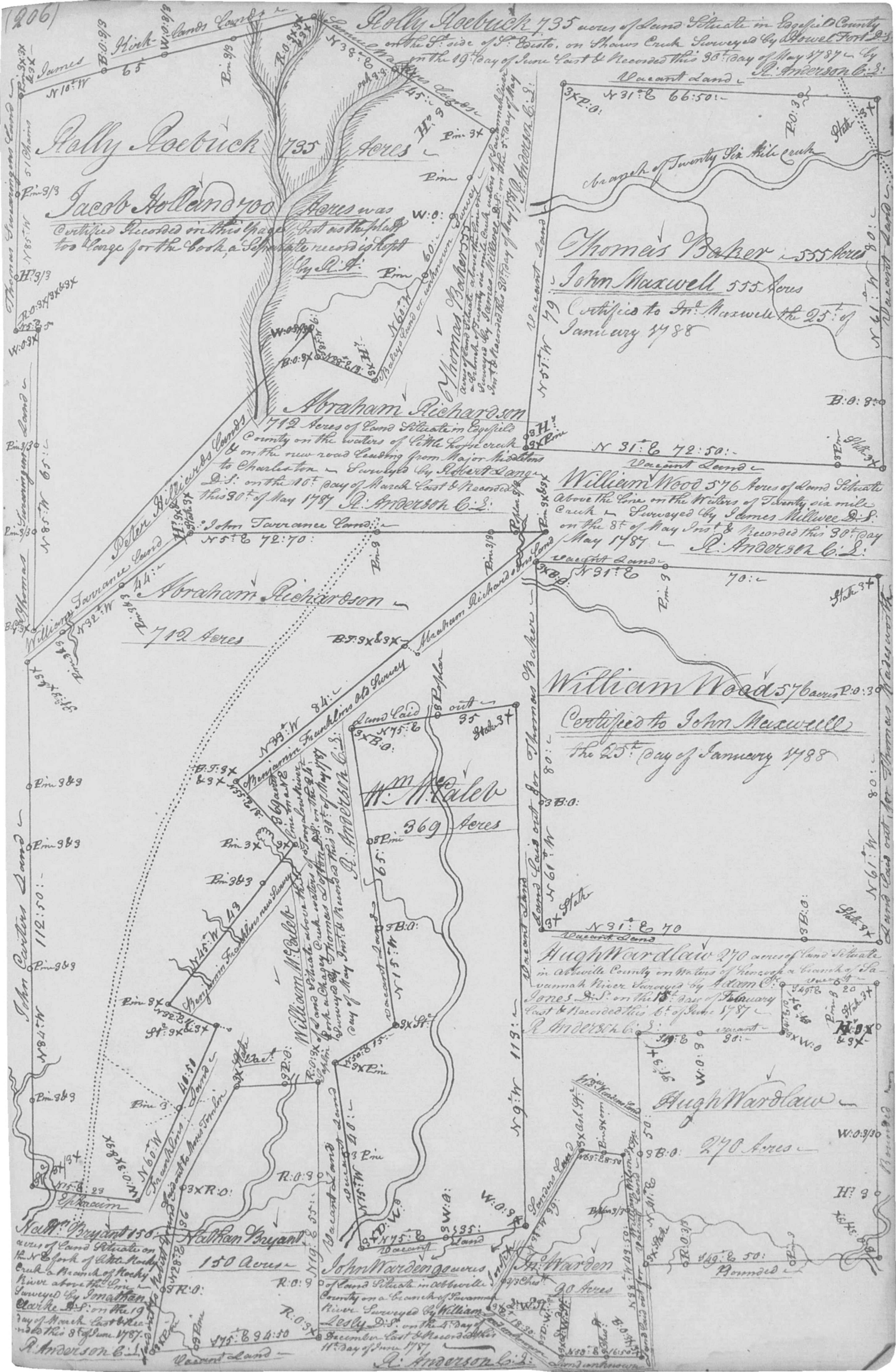

John Warden 90 Acres of Land Situate in Abbeville County on a Branch of Savannah River Surveyed by William Lesly D.S. on the 5th day of December last & Recorded this 11th day of June 1787 R. Anderson C.S.
