Plantation or tract of Land containing two hundred and forty two acres lying and being in
Pendleton County on Shoal Creek of Saluda Beginning Spanish Oak thence running S 55 E 50 to a
Stake thence thence N 75 E 60 to a c. 175 W 50 to a post Oak thence South 44 E to the
Beginning it being a certain tract of Land Granted to Sutton Gunn bearing date the seventeenth
day of May one thousand seven hundred and Eighty seven Together with all and singular the
Rights, Titles, privileges and demands whatsoever Growing to or with the same or accepted Reputed
deemed taken or known as part or parcel thereof and I the said Ichu Lollar do warrant and forever
Defend the said two hundred and forty two acres of Land unto him the said James Allen his heirs
and assigns forever from my self my heirs Executors Administrators and assigns and from all
and every Other person and manner of Persons from laying any Right or Just Claim or demand to the same

One thousand seven hundred and ninety eight and in the twenty second of the American Independ-
