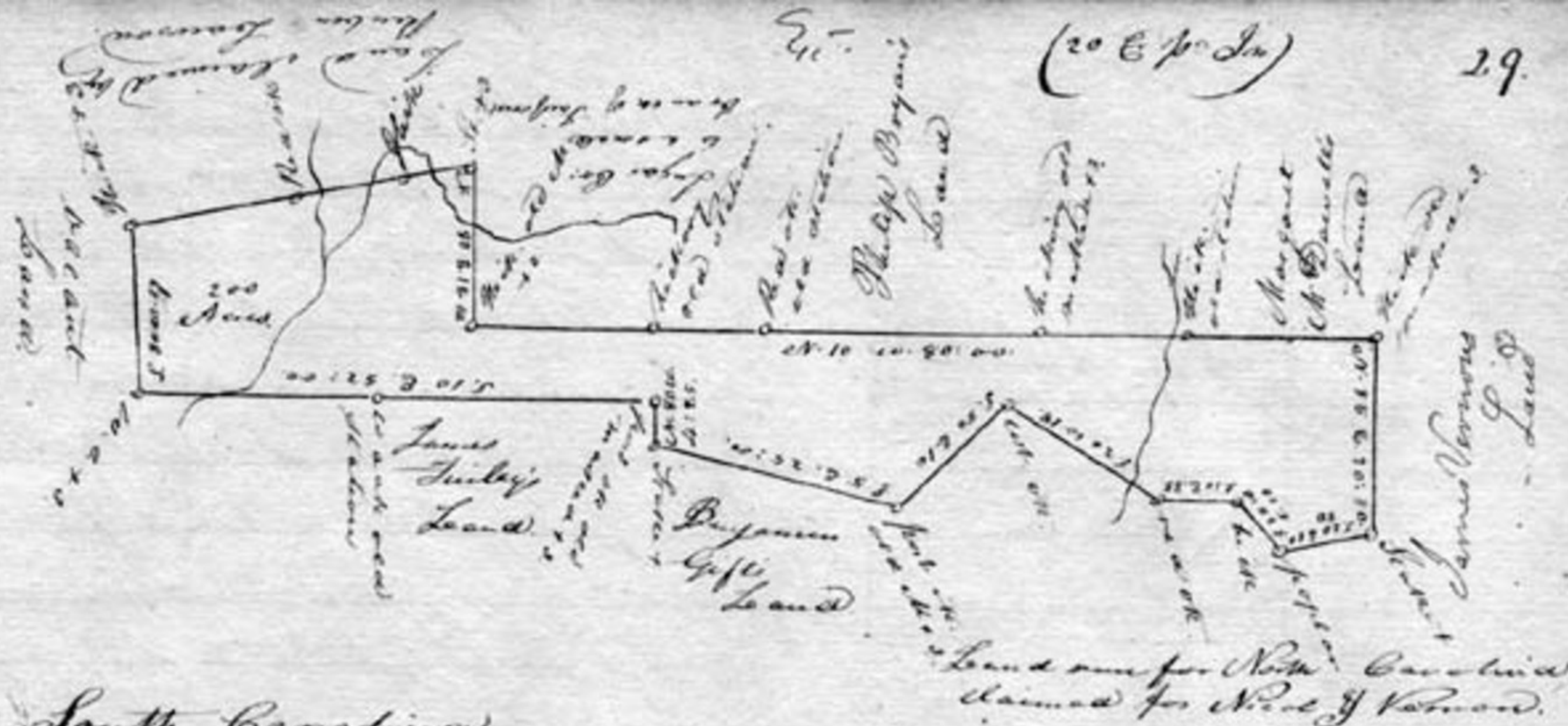




South Carolina.

G.O. dated November 5th 1771, I have measured and laid out unto James Martin a plantation or tract of land in Craven County containing two hundred acres, situate lying and being in the fork between Sugar Creek and Fairforest, Bounded North by James Vernon's land, and North by, Margaret M. Danwell's land, Philip Bryan's land, and land claimed by Reuben Lawson, and South by land run for North Carolina, claimed by West of Vernon, and by Benjamin Giff's land and James Finley's land, and South by vacant land. And to the said plot gave form and marks as the above plot represent.
